Press On: United in the Grace and Love of Christ | Philippians 1:7-11

Use this review as a means for digging deeper into these verses and growing in your understanding of God's Word this week. Here's a few tips:

- Grab your Study Bible and a pen.

- Take your time to answer these questions thoughtfully.
- Share your answers with your spouse, family, or a friend.

Begin by reading **Philippians 1:7-11**.

In **verses 7-8**, we see that the grace and love of Christ **unites us in fellowship**.

Do you miss coming to church? What do you miss the most?

As a church family, why is our salvation in Christ a stronger bond than any other human bond?

How do you think God will use this season to strengthen our church?

Verse 9 tells us that the grace and love of Christ **grows our love with knowledge and discernment**.

Christ's love for us is self-sacrificing. How can we love each other like that?

How can we be assured our love is growing in knowledge and discernment?

Verses 10-11 show us that the grace and love of Christ **compels us to action**.

Is there any fruit in your life that evidences a love growing in knowledge and discernment?

How does dwelling on the gospel lead us away from self-preservation and towards self-sacrifice?

Pray and thank God for our church family. Ask him to bring revival to our church and all churches around the world. Ask him to grow our love in knowledge and discernment, bearing fruit and action.
