

# Sermon Review | Sunday, May 17

Press On: Better Together | Philippians 2:19-30

Use this review as a means for digging deeper into these verses and growing in your understanding of God's Word this week. Here's a few tips:

- Grab your Study Bible and a pen.
- Print this page out, or write your answers in your own journal.
- Take your time to answer these questions thoughtfully.
- Share your answers with your spouse, family, or a friend.

Begin by reading **Philippians 2:19-30**.

Paul considered Timothy and Epaphroditus his family. *Do you consider fellow church members to be like family? Why or why not?*

*What steps have you taken to get to know other members at Kernan better?*

Throughout this passage, Paul describes the actions of Timothy and Epaphroditus as loving sacrificially. *Whose example earlier in chapter 2 did Paul use to show what it means to love sacrificially? (Read Philippians 2:4-8).*

The key to loving our biological *and* church families sacrificially is by dwelling on, and becoming more grateful for, the sacrifice Jesus made for us.

*How often, and in what way, do you take time to dwell on the truth of the gospel? How do you usually feel after thinking intently about what Christ has done for you?*

One of our Core Values at Kernan is, “We serve the interests of others before our own.” **(Phil 2:1-5)**

*How have you served someone else's interests at church recently? How can you do this when we come back to campus?*

We love sacrificially, as a family, for the advancement of the gospel. And Jesus gets the glory for this! *What are you doing currently to “advance the gospel”?*

**Pray** and thank God for adopting you into his family. Ask him to help you love your church family sacrificially. Ask him to help you love others in this way so the gospel may advance around you.
