The Way of Christ | Philippians 2:1-11

Use this review as a means for digging deeper into these verses and growing in your understanding of God's Word this week. Here's a few tips:

- Share your answers with your spouse, family, or a friend.

Begin by reading Philippians 2. Remember this event happened in Philippi and Paul is writing from prison.

Why does Paul ask so many "if" questions?

What does each statement mean?

What response does Paul hope they will invoke in the Philippians?

What gives Paul joy? What gives you joy?

Question of the day, if someone were to ask you, what makes Christianity different from all other religions, what would your answer be and how would you explain it?

Paul calls for the Philippians to be united together in the church and to care for others.

Why is it so important to care for others?

What are some ways we can care for others?

C. S. Lewis says, "humility is not thinking less of yourself, but thinking of yourself less."

What would our society look like if we had this mindset?

If we are to follow the example of Christ, where does this start?

What were 2 ways Christ showed humility?

Christ humbled Himself and obeyed the Father unto death, even death on a cross. What was the result of that?

Pray and thank Jesus for humbling Himself and coming to earth for us. Thank Him for giving us a perfect example of unity and humility. Ask Him to help you be united with Him and to faithfully submit yourself to Him so you can follow His example.
